

## CHAPTER II

### GENERAL REVIEW

#### 2.1 History of Center For Excellence Angkasa Pura I

As Incheon International Airport Corporation (IIAC) has the best Human Resource Training Campus in the world, the Incheon Airport Human Resources Academy, the Excellent Center, abbreviated as Excel, is also expected to become an international standard training center. All material provided has been adjusted to the standards of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

On July 11, 2011, Angkasa Pura Airports has sent 25 senior managers the level below the Board of Directors to attend the Airport Management Course Batch I at the Incheon Human Resources Academy. All lessons received from world-class airports that will be merged into this international standard Excel.

On this day, Wednesday, September 28, 2011, at the Third Floor Perwara Building, PT Angkasa Pura Airports Managing Director, Mr. Tommy Soetomo, opened Younger Managerial Education as an initial step in developing Excel.

According to the Director of Personnel and General of Angkasa Pura Airport Mr. Yushan Sayuti, "The level of competition in the airport industry has began to increase, so that continuous innovative efforts are needed to make a sustainable competitive company."

With the implementation of this workshop Angkasa Pura Airports also hopes that young managers will be equipped with a practical approach in carrying out risk assessment and risk management so that it can help the management of Angkasa Pura Airports to improve Good Corporate Governance and company performance through increasing managerial competence in accessing and managing companies, both at the corporate level, business units, and business processes in each field.

In the future EXCEL will be open to anyone who wants to improve their knowledge and competency in the management field (airport management). EXCEL Angkasa Pura Airport in collaboration with the Incheon Airport HR Academy, Dunamis which is licensed by International Franklin Covey, and other international management training institutions.

#### History of Angkasa Pura I

The history of Angkasa Pura I as a pioneer of commercialization of airports commercially in Indonesia dates back to 1962. When Indonesian President Soekarno returned from the United States, he affirmed his desire to the Minister of Transportation and Minister of Public Works so that Indonesian airfields could be equivalent to airports in developed countries.

On November 15, 1962 Government Regulation (PP) Number 33 of 1962 concerning the Establishment of the State Company (PN) Angkasa Pura Kemayoran. The main task is to manage and operate Kemayoran Airport in Jakarta, which is currently the only international airport that serves flights to and from abroad in addition to domestic flights.

After going through a two-year transition period, as of February 20, 1964 PN Angkasa Pura Kemayoran officially took over the assets and operations of Kemayoran Jakarta Airport from the Indonesian Government. It was February 20, 1964, which was later determined as the company's anniversary.

On May 17, 1965 based on Government Regulation number 21 of 1965, the Government changed the name of the State Angkasa Pura Kemayoran Company to the Angkasa Pura State Company with the intention of further opening up the possibility of managing other airports in the Indonesian territory.

In the context of the division of airport management areas, based on Government Regulation number 25 of 1987 dated May 19, 1987 the name of the Public Company Angkasa Pura was changed to the Angkasa Pura I Public Company, this was in line with the establishment of the Angkasa Pura II Public Company which was specifically assigned the task of managing the Bandar Soekarno-Hatta Air and Halim Perdanakusuma Airport.

Based on Government Regulation number 5 of 1992, the form of the Angkasa Pura I Public Company was changed to Angkasa Pura I (Persero) Company with Muhani Salim, SH Deed dated January 3, 1993 and obtained the approval of the Minister of Justice by decision number C2-470.HT.01.01 Year 1993 April 24, 1993 and announced in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia number 52 dated June 29, 1993 with the Supplementary State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia number 2914/1993.

On October 24, 1974 based on Government Regulation number 37 of 1974 the Government changed the status of the corporate legal entity from a State Company (PN) to a Public Company (Perum).

On October 1, 1985 Kemayoran International Airport was closed and transferred all of its operations to Soekarno-Hatta Airport.

The latest Articles of Association of the Company were amended based on the resolution of the General Meeting of Shareholders dated January 14, 1998 and were notarized by the Notary deed of Imas Fatimah, SH number 30 dated September 18, 1998. Amendments to the Articles of Association were approved by the Minister of Justice of the Republic of Indonesia number C2-25829.HT. 01.04 1998 dated November 19, 1998 and included in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia number 50 dated June 22, 1999 with the Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia number 3740/1999.
