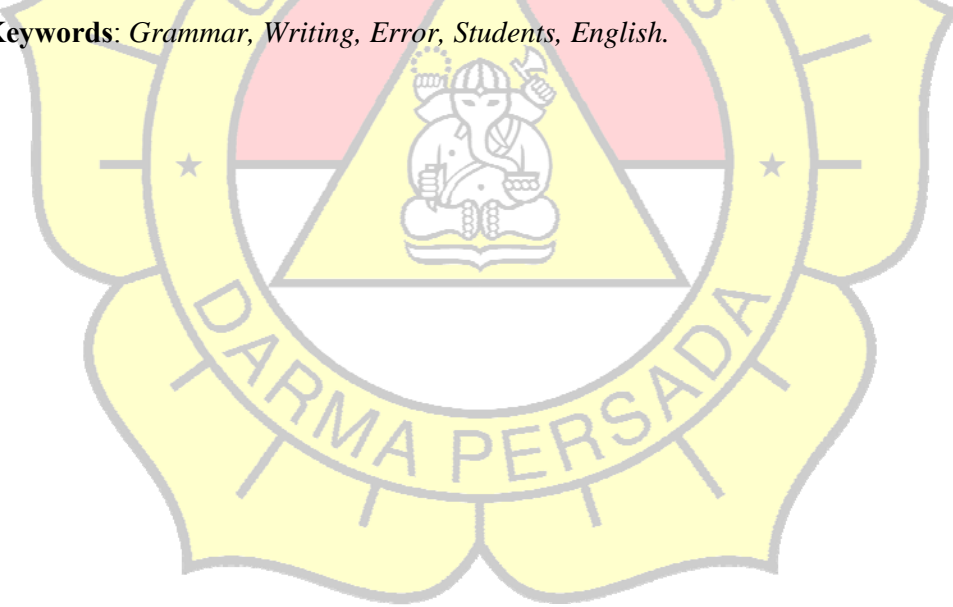


## ABSTRACT

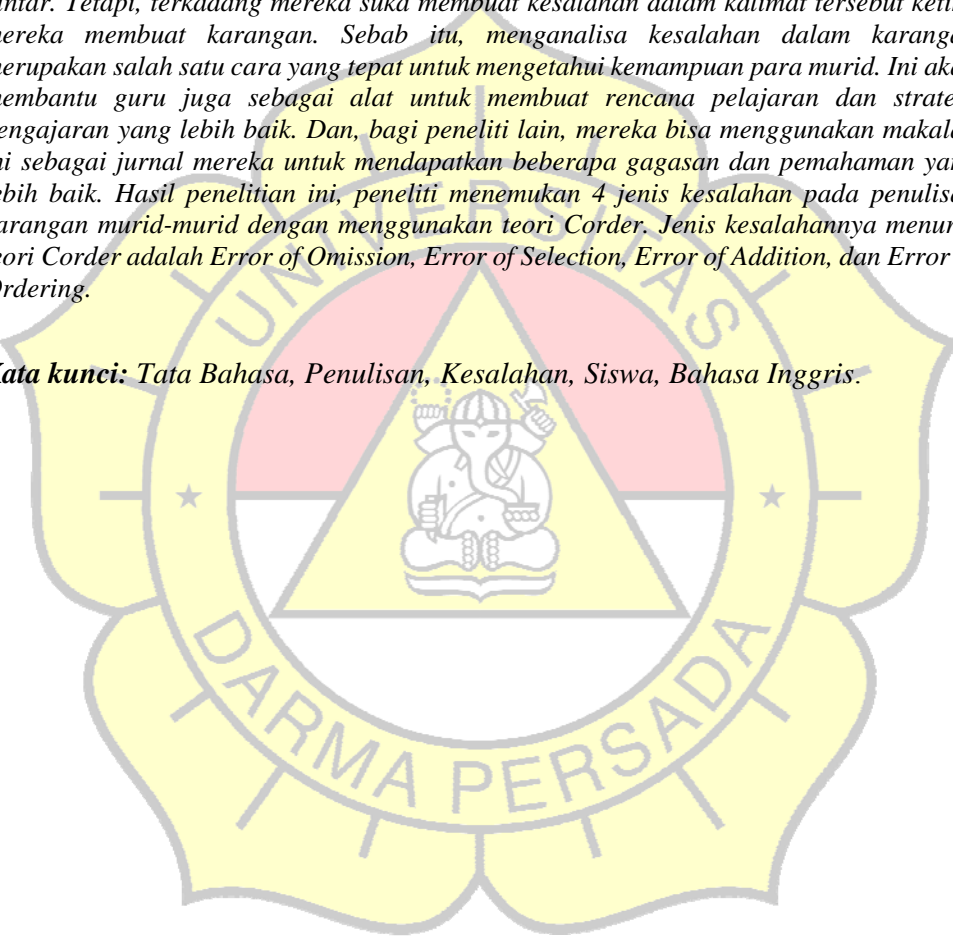

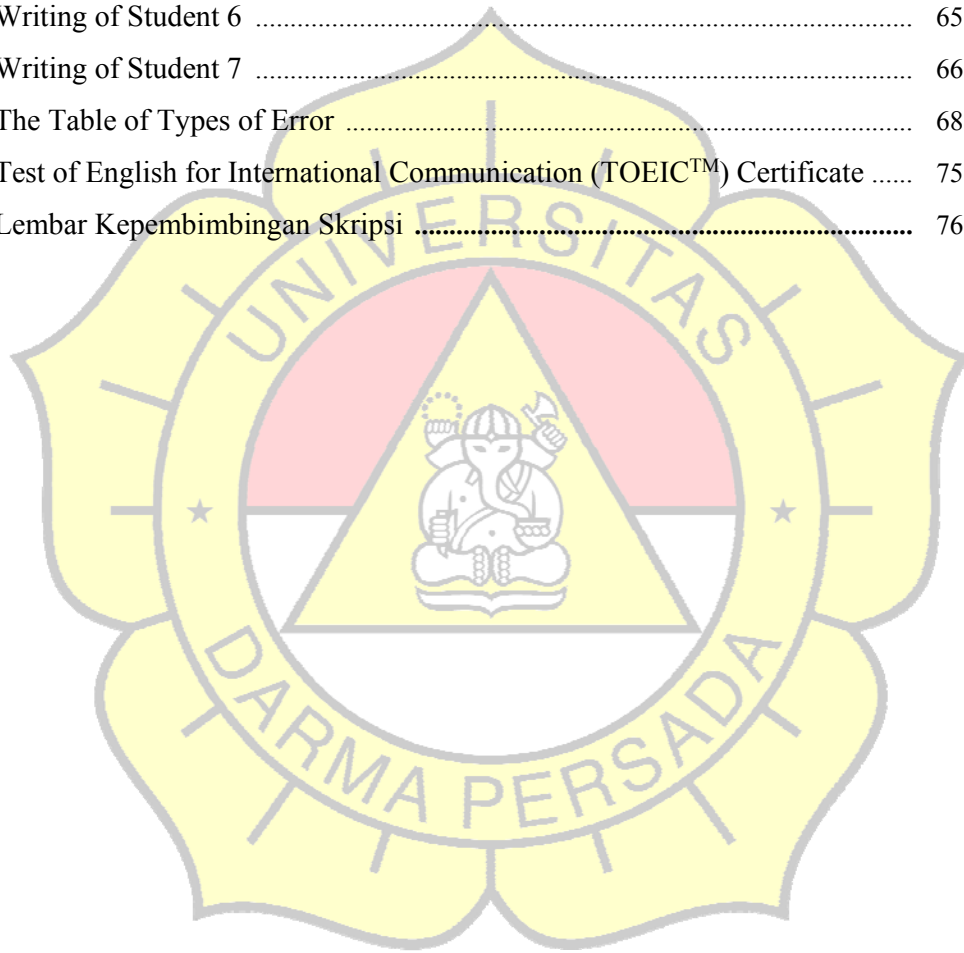

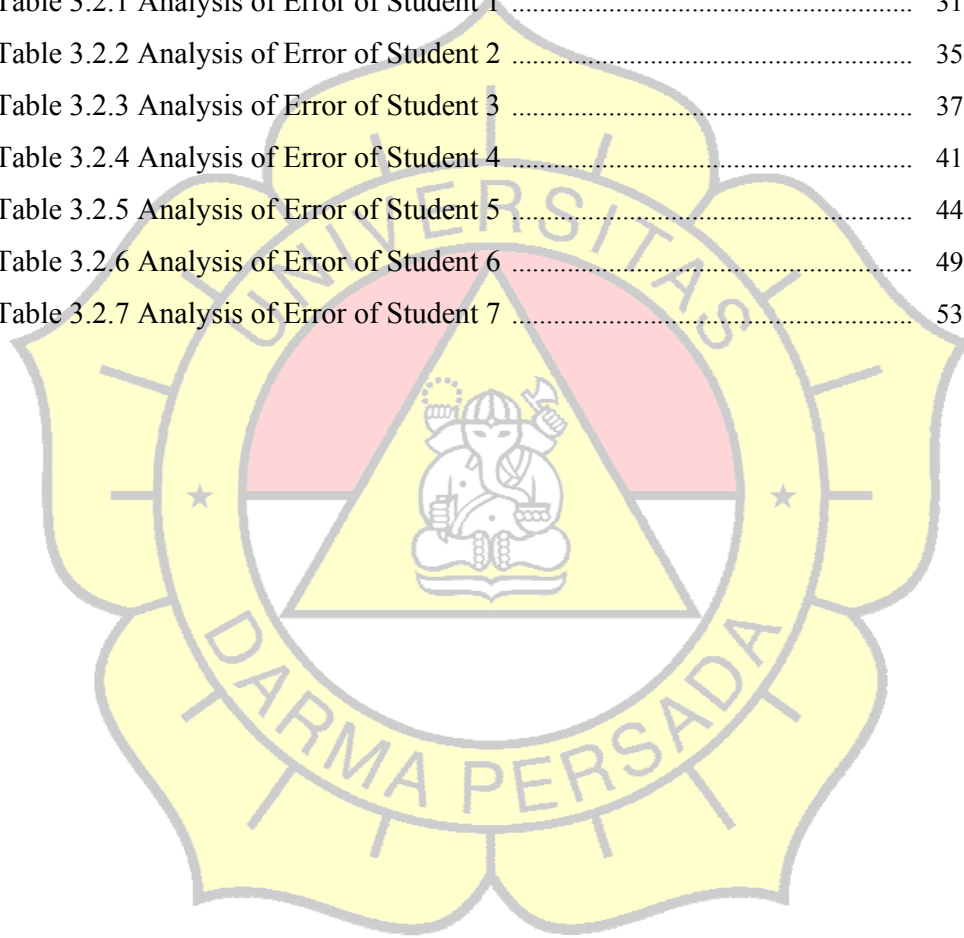
